Old Business:

Regional Events: Check was sent to Lockport Park District this week.

Rockford: Request for re-imbursement \$264 was requested for paperwork supplies. **HRS Scholarship**: The address would be provided to send the scholarship to Jacob Feldhaus.

New Business:

Unit Charters: French Resistance "FTP" more information was needed and the unit commander was unavailable for the meeting.

Defunct Units: 83rd Inf Div, 329th Rgt., I&R platoon: waiting for a reply from the unit commander Tom Stanek. 11th SS Panzergrenadier Division "Nordland",

Panzergrenadier Rgt. 23 Norge had one member in 2009 and 2010. A member in the unit had been contacted. 19 Volkssturm, II.Kompanie had no members in 2011 and there a possible replacement unit commander.

Final Charter Approval: COMNAVAIRPAC met the minimum requirements. A vote was proposed to accept the unit, seconded, and the vote was to accept them as a fully chartered unit.

Treasurer Report: \$10,638.92 reported in checking; \$29,857.26 in savings for \$40,491.18

Secretary Report: 1058 total members

Commonwealth Report: Bryce reported he would contact the 1st Airborne Recce Squadron as they did not have the required minimum membership.

Allied Report: Bill Sheets reported that the 2nd Rangers were having a change of unit commander.

Axis Report: tabled.

Edge Report: The October issue was on the website. Some portion of the contents were left out of this month and would be published next month.

Committee Reports: S&A were considering the FTP charter

GEN: No information.

Election Results: Out of 859 eligible voters 391 voted or 46%. 14 paper ballots were submitted. Ron Kapustka – Secretary 360 votes; Charles Gallagher – Treasurer 356 votes; Rich Russo – Axis Rep 212 votes, Andrew Garrison 104 votes, and Rey Ramirez 75 votes. A survey asked how the voters liked the process and only 5 out of 391 responded negatively.

Online Membership: Online membership applications could be considered. A possible way is to have a code for each unit that the unit commander would provide to their membership when signing up.

Open Comments: Rey Ramirez reported the Rocky Mountain States Regional event had been cancelled due to an unexpected blizzard making the roads impassible.
