A BOD vote was taken and was passed and the event will be the 2020 HRS National Battle. JS than brought up the Saturday meal as a funding possibility. Event staff reported that with an estimated 350 attendants, the meal would be approx. \$3,100.00 and approx. \$800.00 for porta-pots. JS made that motion to

support the event financially up to \$2,000.00, which was seconded by CB. A BOD vote was taken and was passed. The event is to provide final receipts of the expenditures for the meal and porta-pots to the HRS for reimbursement.
