

WWII HRS BOD MEETING

27 December 2007

The meeting was opened at 7:00 pm via conference call with VP Greg Lee, Secretary Jonathan Stevens, and Commonwealth Rep Carl Bogar attending.

The VP announced new unit charters pending are a Free French unit and an Italian unit. A German unit representing the OKW was unanimously voted down, due to the unit's rank heavy structure and for the possibility that in the future abuse could be likely. The VP would find out if the unit idea was to support events and aid event coordinators then the BOD would support it as a secondary impression. The overlapping of the 2nd SS Das Reich unit from Ohio was settled with the current 2nd SS Das Reich unit in Minnesota as long as a different regiment was represented by the Ohio unit.

A member had asked about the co-commander application form. This form will be updated and placed on the website.

The Edge was completed however a new printer was being sought. This should be resolved in a few days.

The Secretary reported HRS ended the year with 947 members.

There was no report from the Treasurer or the President.
